

# Quicken Essentials for Mac Conversion Instructions

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## *Quicken Essentials for Mac 2010*

### *Direct Connect*

As **HarborOne Bank** completes its online banking upgrade, you will need to modify your Quicken settings to ensure the smooth transition of your data. To complete these instructions, you will need your login credentials for the **HarborOne Bank** website.

It is important that you perform the following instructions exactly as described and in the order presented. If you do not, your service may stop functioning properly. This conversion should take 15–30 minutes.

**NOTE:** This update is time sensitive and needs to be completed on or after **8/21/2014**.

## Documentation and Procedures

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### **Task 1: Conversion Preparation**

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1. Backup your data file. For instructions to back up your data file, choose **Help** menu > **Search**. Search for **Backing Up**, select "**Backing up data files**," and follow the instructions.
2. Download the latest Quicken Update. For instructions to download an update, choose **Help** menu > **Search**. Search for **Updates**, select "Check for Updates," and follow the instructions.

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### **Task 2: Deactivate Your Account(s) At HarborOne Bank**

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1. Select your account under the "**Accounts**" list on the left side.
2. Choose **Accounts** menu > **Settings**.
3. Remove the checkmark from "**I want to download transactions**".
4. Click **Save**.
5. Click **Continue** when asked to confirm this deactivation.
6. Repeat steps 2 – 5 for each account at **HarborOne Bank**.

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### **Task 3: Re-activate Your Account(s) at HarborOne Bank**

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1. Select your account under the "**Accounts**" list on the left side.
2. Choose Accounts menu > "Update Selected Online Account".
3. Click "List" > Select **HarborOne Bank**.
4. Click "**Continue**".

**NOTE:** Select "Direct Connect" for the "Connection Type" if prompted.

5. Enter your **Login Credentials** for **HarborOne Bank**.
6. In the "Choose your Accounts" screen, ensure you associate each new account to the appropriate account already listed in Quicken. Under the Action column, you will want to select your existing account.

**IMPORTANT:** Do NOT select "ADD" under the action column.

7. Repeat step 6 for each additional account you wish to download into Quicken Essentials.
8. Click "**Save**".
